


## What does a Plan Manager do?




There are three ways that you can manage your NDIS plan:


- self-manage
- -plan-manage
- -NDIA-manage.



You can decide which way of management you want. You can have a combination of different types if you want.



If you choose plan-management, then you will be able to have a Plan Manager. They do a similar job to an accountant.



PlanCare is a plan-management organisation, with lots of great Plan Managers.







If you choose planmanagement, your providers will send their invoices to the Plan Manager.




The Plan Manager pays the invoice using your NDIS funding.








Choosing to have be planmanaged means that you can use non-NDIS registered providers.



This gives you more choice about the providers you want to use.





Plan Managers track your spending, to make sure you won't run out of money.



They also make sure your providers aren't charging you too much.



Plan Managers keep records of payments made, so you don't have to.



Plan-management is free, and available to everyone.
